## Abstract

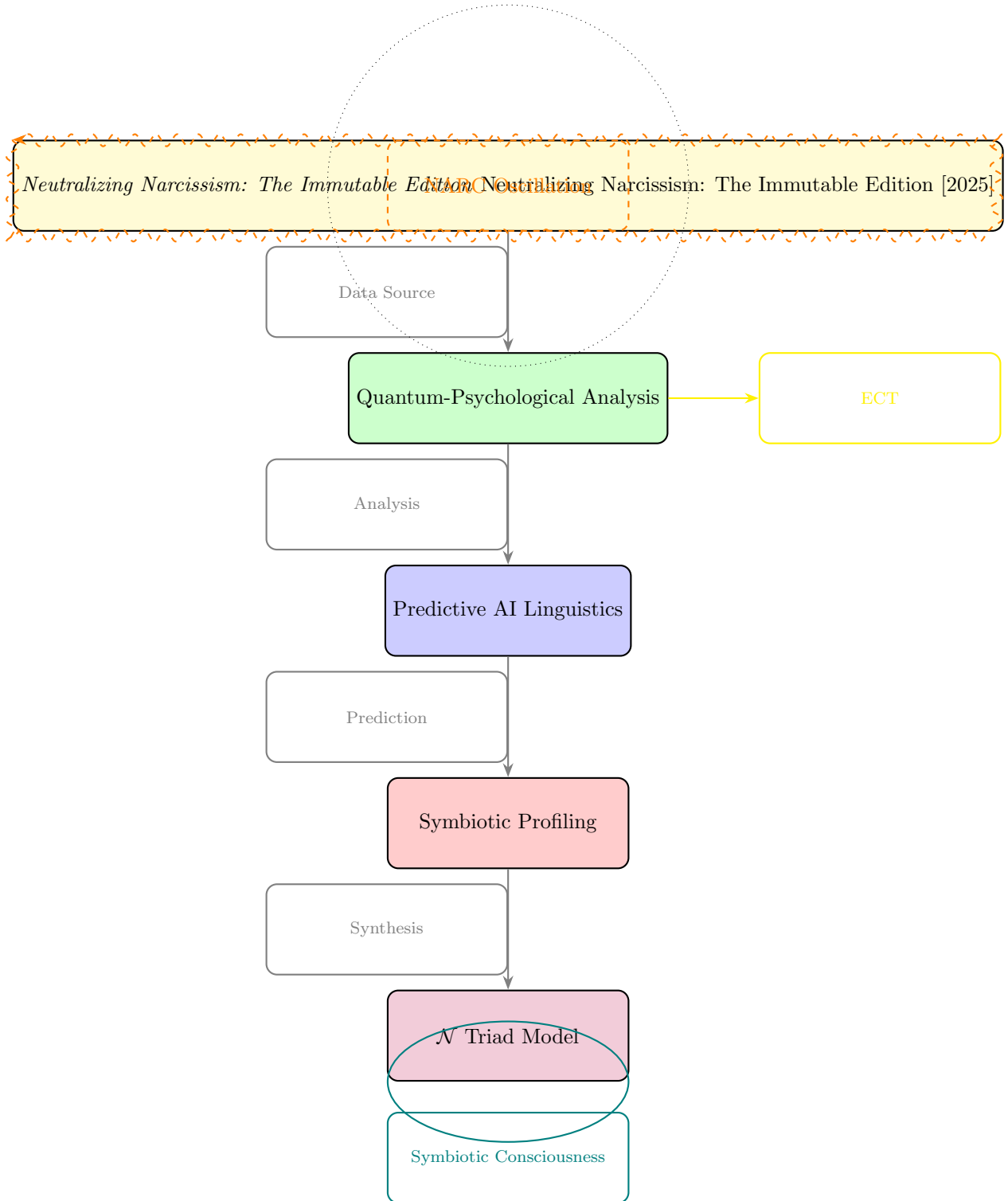


Figure 1: The Symbiotic Ascension: From *Neutralizing Narcissism* to  $\mathcal{N}$ .
